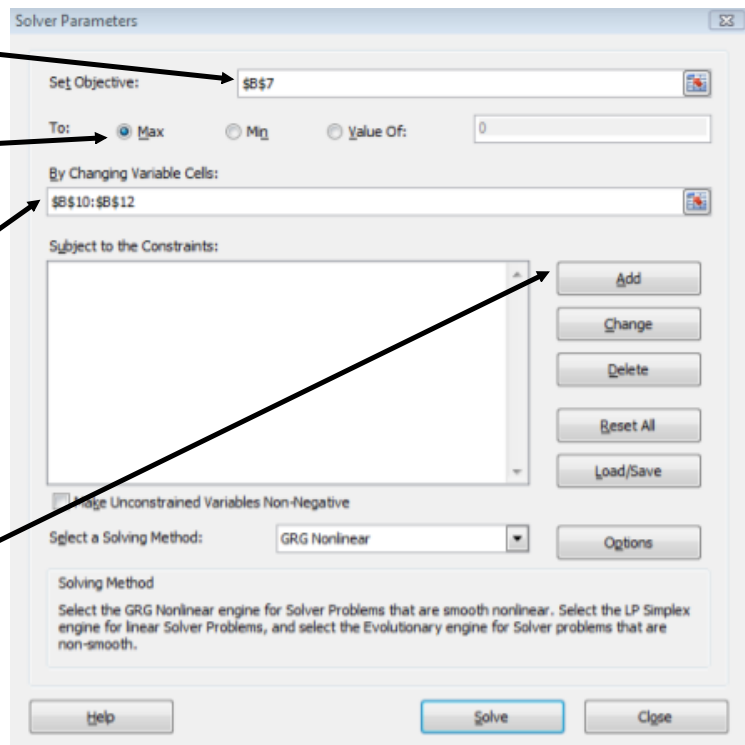


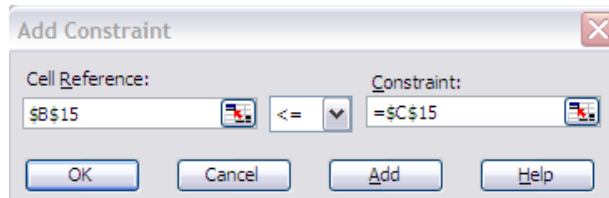
**Step 1:** Set the target cell to the cell that gives the value of the objective function and set style of the objective function.

**Step 2:** Set the "By Changing Cells". This is the cells that where the solution is located.

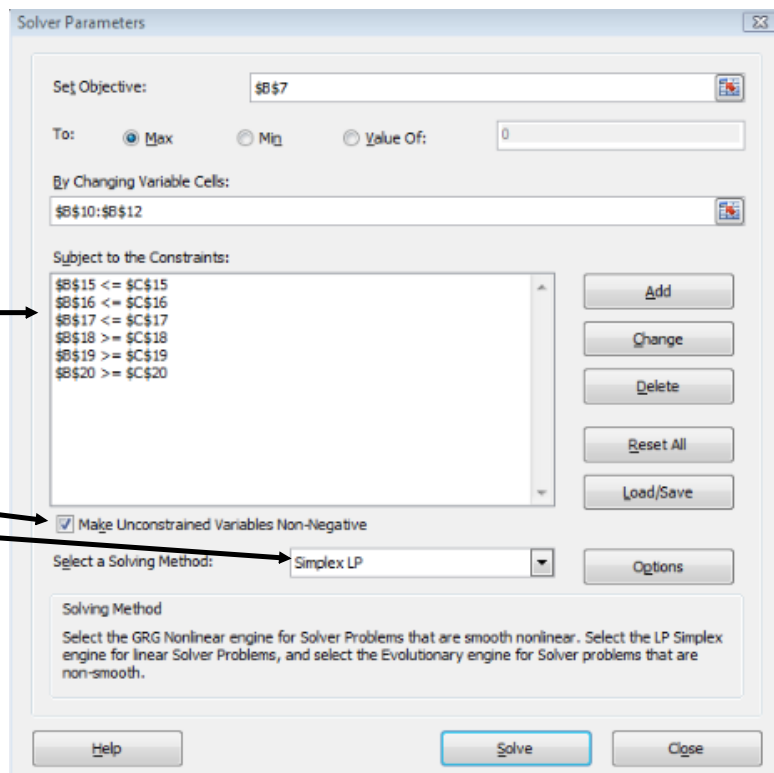
**Step 3:** Now set up the constraints. Click on the Add button.



Edit the add constraint window to show the first constraint and press OK.

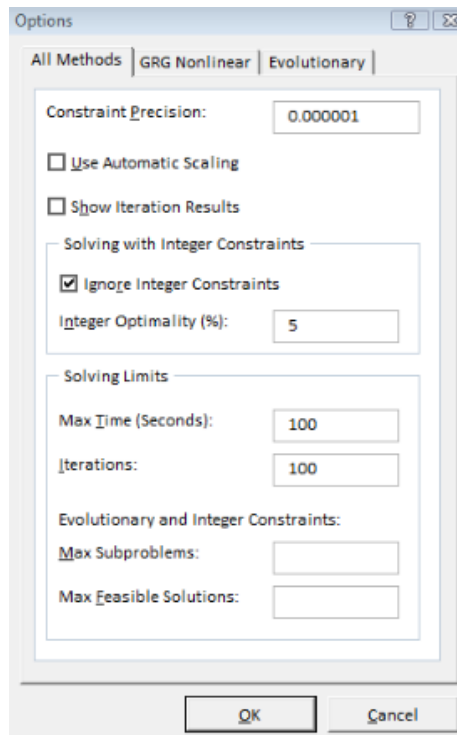


Now enter the rest of the constraints.

**Step 4:** Click on options to get the solver option window shown below. Check to make sure that your options match the ones displayed to the right.



**Step 5:** After clicking solve in the Solver Parameters window, you can pick what results are shown by Excell. Click on **Answer** and **Sensitivity** to get those results.
