


Aspreadsheet usually has a quick way to do some basic calculations. Right clicking on the word sum (if it is not shown then this section of the spreadsheet) brings up a menu of quick commands: Average, CountA, Count, Sum,... Select any of the information that you want.(I selected sum)

Now highlighting the cells(shown below) will give the sum. For this sheet, this represents the interest earned in the first year of the account.
